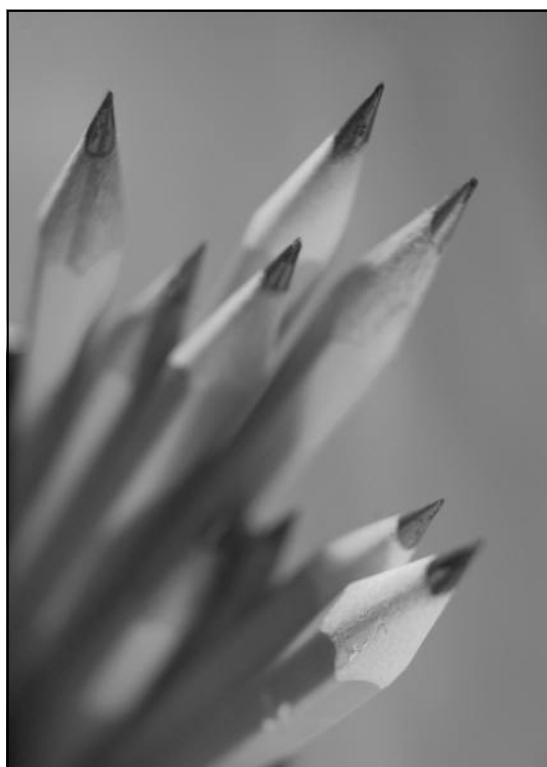

Eligibility

The grants are intended to assist **full time students to undertake a first degree (or other qualification) at a tertiary level (eg university, TAFE, college)**. The awards are made annually and are intended to help students with books, equipment, and other education related costs. Eligibility for an award is determined after taking into account such factors as proven scholastic ability, as well as the financial and economic needs of applicants and their family.

All applicants must be: of good character; an Australian citizen or permanent resident, studying at a university or other Western Australian institution; a resident of Western Australia; and sponsored by a current WA Freemason (if a student does not know a Freemason, staff at Grand Lodge will happily put them in contact with someone in their local area).

Conditions and Disclaimer

- The grants are awarded primarily to assist deserving students in **necessitous circumstances**.
- Students must be studying full time.
- The application must be sponsored by a Western Australian Freemason who is a current member of a WAC Lodge.
- Applications without a Sponsor will not be considered.
- No late applications will be considered.
- **The decision to approve or reject an application is the right of the Grand Lodge. This decision is final and no correspondence or other communication will be entered into.**

Submission Procedure

1. Complete this application form and attached supporting documentation. If there are questions that are not relevant to you or unable to be completed, please do not leave blank, but state why you were unable to complete that section.
2. Arrange a meeting with your Freemason Sponsor. If you do not know any Freemasons, please contact Grand Lodge who will be happy to contact a Lodge in your local area.
3. Your Sponsor will then sign and forward your form to the Grand Lodge for processing.
